Dear FAITH Baseball Players & Parents,

You are receiving this letter as confirmation that you are registered to participate in the FAITH Spring, 2010 Baseball Season. We are glad that you have chosen to participate with us!

The season is upon us, so we wanted to give you some final reminders and also some additional information.

Attached you will find the most up-to-date schedule; however as with any sport, there are typical mid-season changes, so please be patient. (The schedule is not complete, I will be adding a few more games, so please be patient.) If there is a change, we will do our best to contact you personally by phone, an email will be sent and the website will be updated. For the most up-to-date information and changes, check the website at [www.faithhomeschool.net](http://www.faithhomeschool.net) under the calendar section. Please check the website before you leave for each game so you will not experience any unnecessary travel time and expense. Practices will be held at Lapeer Community Church – 80 N. Lake Pleasant Road, Attica, MI 48412. Travel to away games is the player’s responsibility. All away game addresses are listed on the website and can be mapped right from the calendar for driving directions! I have included a list of “Our Players” so that carpooling to practices and games may be possible if needed. If you cannot make it to a game, please make direct contact with one of your coaches to let them know, as soon as you know. We realize that things may come up; however, we hope that you will take this commitment to your team seriously so that it will not be necessary to forfeit a game due to lack of participation. This would be disappointing, but if we know ahead of time that we will not have enough players, we can cancel a game rather than forfeit (this will save everyone travel time too). Communication is vital for this program to run smoothly!

The team will be coached by Carl Schultz (810-724-6016) & Jeff Kauzlarich (810-724-1871).

Our Jr. High/Middle School teams are beginning level teams with an “all play” agenda. Our coaches will make it their goal to play all players within each game (a game at the Jr. High/Middle School level consists of 7 innings); however, even at these levels it is not an all “equal” play as it is much too difficult to regulate how much time each player has played.

Lastly, I would like to remind all of you that participation on a FAITH team means that we not only are representing FAITH, but most importantly, we are representing our Lord & Savior Jesus Christ. By this we expect that everyone will dress modestly to, from and during all practices and games (shorts should be knee length and no tank tops). Also, our attitudes on and off the field (and in the stands) should be pleasing as well. If you have a concern, please direct it to the director, or speak to your coach(es) directly. Please do not discuss concerns with each other as this may cause dissention amongst the team players and parents. When you address a concern, please do it respectfully; I am sure you will find that our coaches and myself are willing to discuss any matter that concerns you. Also, please remember that our coaches are volunteers; they are taking time out of their schedules to teach/coach your children as a service to your family. If a situation arises, it will be dealt with immediately. Dismissal of a player is at the discretion of the FAITH Board and Director. I am confident that this will not be necessary, but must be mentioned.

We are looking forward to a great season! Thanks, again, for choosing to participate with FAITH during the upcoming season and thank you, in advance, for your cooperation in the above matters.
